Alumni of '78: Theta's Keiser, Psi's Spitzig

Chi Phi Alumni of the Year for 1978 are Edmund Spitzig, Jr., Psi 57 (Lehigh), and Fred Kieser, Jr. Th 62 (Rensselaer).

The recognition plaques were presented at the Birmingham Congress, although Spitzig was unable to attend.

The strong "class" of nominees included also: Peter Amann H 68 (Georgia), James Embree A-T 69 (Michigan), Elwood McKnight ED 33 (Oregon State), Richard Owens G 48 (Emory), and Kris Whitten SD 70 (UC Davis).

Spitzig is Active Lehigh Alumnus; Bethlehem Steel Exec

A year after he graduated in 1957, Lehigh Chi Phi alumni elected Ed Spitzig as a Trustee of the Briarfield Association which is the chapter's alumni and house association. At that time he served through 1961, but was reelected in 1971 and has served as its President since 1972.

He has been in the Sales Department of Bethlehem Steel since he graduated, serving as District Office Salesman in Baltimore and Chicago 1960-1970. He returned to Bethlehem in 1970, and is assistant manager of Sales for Carbon and Alloy Bars.

He is married and the father of four

daughters, aged 16 to 6.

In addition to his Briarfield work, he is president of the Fraternity Alumni Council at Lehigh (1976-1979), and was its vice president 1973-1976. He served as alumni representative to the Fraternity

Management Association board 1975-1977, and is currently on the board of the Lehigh Home Club since 1976, being elected vice president this year.

He is a Trustee of the Central Moravian Church at Bethlehem, and served eight years in the Army reserves, retiring as a Captain.

"Country Lawyer", Kieser Is Theta Leader, Active Nationally

Since 1971, when he became president of Theta Chapter's alumni association, alumni gifts, a mortgage, plus student labor, have almost totally rebuilt the chapter house at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute.

A self-described "simple country lawyer", Kieser lives almost in the shadow of New York's skyscrapers in Metuchen, N. J. After graduating in Building Science from RPI—where he was Chapter Steward and Alpha—he went to law school at the University of North Carolina, receiving his LL.B. in 1966. He is also a part-time farmer, raising Charolais cattle, corn, hay and oats in Pennsylvania. He describes himself as an axid hunter

Kieser was married in 1963, has no children. He has attended about half of the last 10 congresses, and served as alumni advisor when the subject of initiation of women came up at the Rhode Island Congress. He was regional Council Representative 1977-78, and was

named Grand Gamma at Birmingham.

He served as Deputy Attorney General, State of New Jersey, 1969-70, Municipal Prosecutor in 1972, and is a member of the Mt. Zion Lodge #135, Masons. His effort in politics was unsuccessful ("I was a Republican") when he ran for local office.

Chi Phi at Indiana U. Leads in Food, Safety

A comparison by Indiana University of the Health and Food Service at fraternities, and Fire and Safety, showed Iota Delta Chapter at the top of the list in both among the national fraternities.

In Health and Food Service, Chi Phiwas rated 83.4%, compared to a low of 46.3% for the lowest ranking frat. In Fire and Safety, the Chi Phi ranking was 56%, compared to 12.4% for the lowest. A local club (Evans Scholars) ranked 81.9% on fire and safety, probably because it has no food service.

A strong turn-out of actives and alumni from throughout the nation received Alabama hospitality in full measure when the 1978 Chi Phi Congress met in Birmingham, Aug. 9-13.

The three-day Congress was preceded by two days of the Krannert Leadership Seminar, produced for actives under sponsorship of the Chi Phi Educational Trust. Meetings of the Trust and of the Grand Council were also hold.

Major actions:

Large increases were voted in the pledge fee (from \$31.10 to \$35) and the initiation fee (from \$85 to \$110). National Director Ray Donohue Ome 61 reported that these increases would put Chi Phi at the middle among national fraternities in what they charge during four years of college, although some fraternities charge annual dues.

J. Darryl McCall, ThD 50, G 52, PsiD 70, was re-elected Grand Alpha for a third term beginning at the 1979 Congress, over Bates Block, G 40, H 42. McCall became the first three-term Grand Alpha in over 40 years as he asked re-election to complete his plans to make the fraternity financially sound by appealing to alumni for capital donations and other support, and by expansion

Madison, Wis., was named as the site of the 1979 Congress, with Kappa Chapter as host. Congress sessions will be held in the Memorial Union, and delegates will be housed at Madison's newest hotel, The Concourse. Chapter house, Union and hotel are all within easy walking distance.

Bro. Byrd Nominated For Florida Bishopric

The Rev. Richard E. Byrd, ThD 50, an Episcopal priest, is one of seven candidates nominated as Bishop Coadjutor of Southeast Florida, to succeed the Rt. Rev. James L. Duncan when he retires within the next two years. Election is scheduled Nov. 4.

Fr. Byrd is currently executive vice president and chaplain, Wilson Center for Education and Psychiatry, Faribault, Minn.

If elected, Bro. Byrd would become Bishop automatically when Bishop Duncan retires.

Trust Needs Broad Base of Gifts to Carry Out Its Charitable Program

A broad base of donations from many alumni is needed by the Chi Phi Educational Trust to maintain its status as a "public" Trust and to carry on its charitable program within Chi Phi.

So reported Melvin R. Jessup HD 45, Chairman, to the Chi Phi Congress in Birmingham. The complete report will be published in the December Chakett.

During the fiscal year ending last July 31, the Trust:

Loaned \$9,931 to 20 students.

Gave 25 scholarships totaling \$7,745 to actives in 17 chapters.

Made Library improvement grants of \$1,500 each to Alpha-Alpha chapter at North Carolina and Alpha Delta chapter at Penn State.

Financed the two-day Herman Krannert Leadership Conference for two actives from each chapter, held in conjunction with the Congress, with 36 chapters attending.

Divided \$1000 in prize money among six chapters who did excellent work raising money for Muscular Dystrophy: Alpha Theta Chi, Nebraska; Theta Delta, Florida; Psi Delta, UNC Charlotte; Zeta, Franklin and Marshall; Delta Xi, West Virginia Wesleyan. Alpha Theta Chi was especially noted because it raised more than \$15,000 for the charity.

Made grants to the University of Georgia, West Virginia Wesleyan College, Lafayette College and Emory University for housing programs involving Chi Phi chapter houses.

During the 1978 Congress, library improvement grants were approved for Xi Delta Chapter, Florida Institute of Technology, and Phi Delta Chapter at Tennessee.

Two members whose terms have ended were recognized for their service: Jack C. Fraser H 43, and Bates Block G 40 H 42.

Their successors—Richard Gilbert P 62, and Edward O. Wayson, Jr., PsiD 70—were introduced and sat in on the meeting.

Election of officers for the 1978-79 fiscal year was held, with Melvin R. Jessup HD 45 as chairman, Harold Steinke K 43 vice chairman, A. R. Updike, Jr., ThD 43, secretary, and William R. Kitchin A 49 treasurer.

In urging alumni donations, Jessup also pointed out:

1) The rising cost of higher education increases the need for more and larger scholarships and student loans.

2) Our newer chapters need help for satisfactory housing.

3) The library-study area program needs to be extended to more of the older chapters.

He noted that what the Trust has given, plus operating costs which steadily rise, has exceeded income from investments for a number of years, making donations essential.

Are There Any Other Jesuits?

Tony Ozzimo BZ 76 has concluded his novitiate in the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) and has taken vows. He writes:

I am now studying philosophy at Loyola University in New Orleans for preparation to the priesthood which is about eight years away. Jesuit formation is traditionally very academic and long but results in a man who is well-formed in prayer and studies.

I am curious if there have been any Chi Phis who have become Jesuits or Catholic priests? I wonder if in any of the northern chapters (where there are more Catholics) any of our brothers have taken up the religious life? I don't know of anyone mentioned in The Chakett or in our (Florida) newsletter, but I would be interested if there is.

I really enjoy reading about the chapters and especially my chapter, Beta Zeta. It sounds like everything is fine and the chapter is growing.

My prayers continue for the continued success and well-being for our great fraternity.

Bell & His Lafayette 50th

Lafayette class reunion records toppled as the Class of 1928, headed by Joseph E. Bell Rho 28 as president for many years, held its 50th reunion last June.

Aided by a strong reunion chairman and his own 40 years of work from graduation until retirement in 1968 as Lafayette's first full-time alumni secretary, Bell reports the following records:

The class gift to the college of over \$133,000 was more than double any previous 50-year class gift.

The 50-year class had both the highest percentage of returning grads (over 80%), and also the highest number attending of all the classes having reunions in 1978, which, he notes, "is uncommon—a first at Lafayette for any class."

As a result, his Class elected him "president emeritus" when he gave up the active presidency preparatory to moving permanently to Delray Beach, Fla., where he has been spending six months a year.

The following is excerpted from an article in Lafayette's "Alumnus" published when he retired 10 years ago.

Joe Bell came up the hard way—the muscular way, in fact. He was named captain and quarterback of the city's All-Scholastic team in 1923 at Philadelphia's Northeast High School. When a knee injury in his first college season halted his gridiron career, he switched to soccer as a center halfback for coach "Scotty" Cuthbertson and to baseball as Bill Coughlin's first baseman for three seasons.

During his sophomore year he was the very exacting president of the Calumet Club which was responsible for teaching tradition to the Class of 1929. Arthur Phillips '29 recalls of Joe, "His ferocity in dealing with us was such that today he is the only member of Calumet 1 still remember."

In balance, he was known at the same

time by the members of the Chi Phi fraternity as their "most congenial" brother.

Lafayette never had a full-time alumni secretary prior to Joe's appointment a few weeks before his graduation in June 1928.

In 1946 the faculty in a formal resolution presented by Dr. James W. Tupper and sent to Alumni Council by Dr. William M. Smith '03, clerk of the faculty, commended Joe for stimulating, through the alumni magazine, the interest of alumni in the academic side of the College.

In addition to keeping the alumni informed, Joe Bell operated on the premise that since the alumni were the most important asset of the College they should be involved in the meaningful affairs of the institution.

Over a period of four decades he attained a remarkable record in selecting for recommendation to various alumni offices men of ability and interest in Lafavette.

As to the 50th Reunion, Bro. Bell adds a description useful to all Chi Phi chapters and alumni groups:

Our class program embraced time for nostalgia but we went further. We wanted to give our men and their wives the opportunity to be better informed about the college as it is today. To that end we had walking tours of the campus guided by knowledgeable young men from the Admissions staff and our class forum featuring talks and a question-answer period by the Provost, Director of Engineering, and the Treasurer.

For our class dinner we had the president-elect of Lafayette introduced by the chairman of the Search Committee of the Board of Trustees. To keep our dinner from being stuffy we made it a dinner dance.

Voluntary Alumni Dues Rise

A fourth consecutive year of record (and badly needed) alumni support was recorded during 1977-78, with a total of \$40,521.23 being received, up nearly 20% from 1976-77. The figure does not include gifts made to chapters.

The increase resulted from a rise in the amount requested, however, as the number of alumni contributing decreased from 2,314 to 1,902.

"The \$25 now being asked as a minimum gift is well-justified due to the inflation we've experienced," says Ray Donohue, National Director. "We urge all alumni to send in their dues when notices are sent out soon. These dues now constitute 1/3 of our annual income, and we really need a higher share than that."

Following our annual pattern, the list herewith shows dues-paying members on a chapter-by-chapter basis, including those who gave to a chapter or state association where this was available. Those who gave both nationally and locally are marked with an asterisk. We regret that we did not receive information from all chapters as to their alumni gifts.
